To the Nursery Teacher or Parent:

This book has been designed for you to turn the pages as you sing, pointing to each word. Your baby will learn to read the words actually before they can sing the song.

I encourage you to use the pages to talk about Jesus and the Bible. Describe these words using pictures of Jesus and showing them an actual Bible. You can amplify on your description of the Bible sayings things like “I love the Bible” “The Bible is the Word of God” etc. Perhaps now that you know the concept you can make additional flash cards for the words you use to describe the Bible. There are no pictures because that distracts the baby from focusing on the word. Words are in different colors and fonts to help keep their attention. Pictures can be used to supplement these cards.

The fastest learning period in a child’s life is between birth and 2 1/2 years old. During this time 10’s of thousands of brain connections are being formed. By interaction with your baby and teaching them to read you are strengthening those connections for their lifetime. The first 50 words a baby learns to read need lots of repetition as they come very slow but after that they get on the fast track to learning so enjoy interacting with your baby and don’t give up. Instructions for putting this book together if you have downloaded it from the website.

Print all pages on good inkjet paper so colors are bright.

Buy a package of clear sheet protectors

Put 2 sheets back to back in a sheet protector and cut in half on dotted line. (This works great if you have a paper cutter) You may have to do single sheets if you are cutting by hand. You only need 11 clear sheet protectors.

Then rearrange half sheets so Jesus is on the back of cover sheet, me is on back of love, etc.

You will need to punch an extra hole so you have two holes. Punch through where some of them already have a hole. Secure the song together with metal rings. Pages will turn easily.
